Kinsey Jenkins' IMA Service

Kinsey Jenkins has served IMA in many different areas during his 28-year membership. He has been a volunteer leader in the Columbia Chapter and the Carolinas Council, and a professional leader in the IMA National organization. Whenever there were questions concerning IMA, the volunteer leaders in IMA always knew that they could depend upon Kinsey Jenkins to provide answers. Kinsey Jenkins understood the importance of the Chapters and the Councils in IMA, and he dedicated his entire IMA career to serving the IMA volunteer leaders.

In Honor of Kinsey Jenkins

It is appropriate that the IMA Carolinas Council recognize the volunteer service of its current and future leaders. "Current" is defined as having an active IMA membership status when the nomination is reviewed by the Council. The nominee may be retired and no longer involved in Council activities. The award will be titled, "The IMA Carolinas Council Kinsey Jenkins Service Award". The following passage describes Kinsey Jenkins' service to IMA:

The above passage should be descriptive of all future recipients of this award, and this recognition should be awarded to an IMA Carolinas Council Leader who has dedicated his/her long IMA career to serving IMA members in the Carolinas. The Kinsey Jenkins Service Award will be the most prestigious IMA Award in the Carolinas Council.

Nominations may be made by any IMA Carolinas Council Member. The exception to this rule is that none of the members of the committee taking nominations for their term of service are eligible to be considered. The award recipient will be determined by the Carolinas Council award committee. (See attached form.) The committee will be comprised of the President-Elect who will be the lead, the immediate past president and the current president. Eventually, the two most current winners will also be included to make a maximum committee of five.

This award will be presented at the fall Council meeting each year the committee receives nominees they agree are qualified for this award.
